## HYPHENS

$\propto$ look like stitches
$\propto \ll$ act like stitches
$\infty$ to join words, to Frankenstein words
\&s creating one longer word
cs EX: "six-step process"
$\cos$ it's not a six process
cs it's not a step process
cos it's a six-step process
$\propto \ll$ these hyphenated words function as a single adjective to modify "process"

## Hyphens \& Numbers

catwenty-one, sixty-five, ninety-nine
asforty-year-old victim
$\cos$ (adjective = hyphenated)
casforty year old
cos (noun = not hyphenated)
© hundred-dollar bill
cs ( $\$ 100$ bill)
csfour-hundred-dollar telephone bill
$\mathcal{O}$ (\$400 telephone bill)

## Hyphens \& Prefixes, Suffixes

prefixes are often hyphenated, too cos self- and well-

03 self-esteem, self-centered, self-analysis, selfconscious, self-aggrandizement
$\mathcal{O}_{3}$ self-control, self-destruction, self-deprecating, selfdefense, self-image
os well-meaning, well-intentioned, well-accepted, welladjusted, well-being
©S well-built, well-educated, well-chosen, wellconstructed, well-documented

## Hyphens \& Prefixes, Suffixes

C half- prefix
cs half-time, half-hearted
$\mathcal{O}_{\mathcal{S}}$ half-cocked, half-dead, half-starving
os half-man, half-measure
©s half-minute, half-hour
cos half-pipe, half-track

## Hyphens \& Prefixes, Suffixes

$\bigcirc$ non- prefix
cs non-verbal communication
$\propto<$ half- prefix
cos half-gallon carton of ice cream
${ }_{C S}$ half-crazy with love
$\mathcal{C l}_{\text {semi- prefix }}$
cs semi-sweet chocolate
$\cos$ semi-formal dress, semi-annual sale, semi-pro team

## Hyphens \& Prefixes, Suffixes

## cos

Po-like suffixes are hyphenated
CB (and quite informal, too)
$\mathscr{O}$ animal-like, Greek-like, child-like
$\propto<$ always better to use the more formal word:
\& $\&$ bestial, Hellenic or Greek, childish
$\propto$ see the "animal adjectives" list on our site
$\operatorname{OS}$ (same holds true for -ish words)
